Special Religious Education (SRE) Participation Letter

A feature of the public education system in NSW is the opportunity to provide time in class for education in ethics, faith and morality from a religious or non-religious perspective at the choice of parents/caregivers.

During enrolment, you can choose a special religious education option for your child from the school's available approved providers.

At Moss Vale High, SRE is taught by approved SRE teachers representing all denominations associated with the local SRE Board.
