Special Religious Education (SRE) Participation Letter

A feature of the public education system in NSW is the opportunity to provide time in class for education in ethics, faith and morality from a religious or non-religious perspective at the choice of parents/caregivers.

At Moss Vale High, SRE is taught by Mrs (Pastor) Donna Jensen who has been part of our school since 2002, and is an Ordained Minister with the Australian Christian Churches. Her role is to represent all denominations associated with the local SRE Board. The Southern Highlands Christian Education Association (SHCEA) represents 22 local churches from 10 different denominations and teaches both Protestant and Catholic students.
